Why Join the Easton PTA?

The Easton PTA supports many programs at both Samuel Staples Elementary School (SSES) and Helen Keller Middle School (HKMS); programs that might not otherwise exist. By paying a small membership fee of \$15, parents ensure that these programs will continue. To be a member of the PTA, you are not required to volunteer your time. (Although, your help is always appreciated!)

What Programs Does the Easton PTA Support?

Below is a partial listing of the programs funded and organized by the Easton PTA. For a complete list of all programs supported by the PTA, see our website at www.eastonpta.com.

Telephone Directory—The PTA produces a directory of all SSES and HKMS families that is given to all PTA members. This is a tremendous resource for parents when planning birthday parties, play dates, etc.

SSES Calendar—The PTA produces a SSES calendar that is given to all parents with children at SSES. This is an invaluable organizational tool for busy parents.

School Newsletters—The PTA produces a semi-monthly newsletter for SSES parents (the *SSES Scoop*) and a monthly newsletter for HKMS parents (the *HKMS Cougar Connection*).

HKMS Sports Teams—The PTA provides monetary and volunteer support to several sports teams at the middle school, including Volleyball, Wrestling, Field Hockey, and Skiing. The PTA also provides support to the HKMS Drama Group which puts on a school play each year.

Student Publications—The PTA provides support for student publications at both schools, including SSES Superscribes & Scribblers, the SSES Fifth Grade Yearbook, the HKMS yearbook, and the HKMS Keller Teller student newspaper.

Media Centers—Parents have an opportunity to expand their own libraries during the Scholastic Book Fair at SSES, hosted by the PTA, and at the HKMS spring book fair, where the PTA provides volunteers. A percentage of the sales go to the media centers and to other PTA programs and activities. The PTA also runs a Birthday Book Club at both schools, which provides a way for parents to donate books in their children's names to each school.

Meeting School/Student Needs—The PTA remains responsive to school and student needs throughout the year. Frequently, school based initiatives are brought to our attention, and the Easton PTA supports the schools by providing funding and volunteers.

Student Enrichment—The PTA provides the money for various enrichment programs, including HOTS, which vary each year at both schools.

What Fundraisers Does the PTA Hold Each Year?

Easton PTA fundraisers include: Gift Wrap Sale, Bulb Sale, Scholastic Book Fair, Family Portrait Day, Cookie Dough Sale, Note Card Sale, Sound Tigers game, Comedy Night, Spring Social, Bridgeport Bluefish game, Box Tops for Education, Pizzeria Uno nights, and movies.

What Else Can I Do?

When you join the PTA, you are under no obligation to commit to anything other than your \$15. However, if you have the time and inclination, here's what you can do:

Become a Room Parent (SSES) or Grade Parent Coordinator (HKMS)—PTA members can volunteer to be a room parent in their child's class at SSES, or a grade parent coordinator at HKMS. Room parents at SSES organize class parties throughout the year. Grade parent coordinators at HKMS provide organizational assistance for grade-wide activities. (Please note that due to insurance restrictions, parents who want to volunteer to be a room parent or grade parent coordinator must be a member of the PTA.)

Attend PTA Meetings—The PTA holds monthly meetings and all members are invited to attend.

Take a Position—Volunteer to chair or assist on a PTA committee, or run for a PTA board position.
