Book Drive Update



Thank you to all who contributed books last spring to the very successful book collection for the United Way/Read-to-Grow Book Drive. ***We collected 2,585 books – surpassing our lofty goal of 2,500 -- within two weeks, thanks to contributions from SSES and HKMS families, as well as the general Easton community.***

The project, coordinated by the Easton PTA, several SSES teachers and last year's 5th graders, benefited children in the Fairfield County area by providing new and gently used books to those who otherwise wouldn't have books for their summer reading. The United Way/Read-to-Grow's total goal for this summer reading program was 100,000 and they surpassed it by reaching 101,773, thanks in part to this tremendous contribution from Easton.

Room Parent 101

- ❖ The PTA oversees the Room Parent program, and is looking for four room parents per classroom, for each grade from Pre-K to 5th.
- ❖ You **MUST** be a PTA member to be a room parent. This is an insurance requirement.
- ❖ You may only be a Room Parent for *one child per family*. If a particular class does not have enough volunteers, then we may also allow your second choice as well.
- ❖ If you have any questions, please call Jodi Forte at 203.373.1790.

What are the duties?

- ❖ Attend a Room Parent meeting in September.
- ❖ Collect money from each family for class dues.
- ❖ Designate volunteers to plan and implement each class party. Dates, times and specifics will be discussed with the classroom teacher. Typically parties are held for Halloween, Winter Holidays, Valentine’s Day, and the End-of-the-Year.
- ❖ Organize Teacher Appreciation Week activities, usually held in May.
- ❖ Coordinate classroom volunteers for Field Day, held in June.
- ❖ Work with classroom teacher and PTA on other possible classroom and school-wide events.

How do I sign up?

- ❖ Below slip must be returned to school *no later than September 9th*. No exceptions. Room parents will be chosen by a lottery system.
- ❖ You will be notified by September 17th if you have been selected.
